This Order is made by Warwickshire County Council ("the authority") under section 118 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that the footpath described in paragraph 1 below is not needed for public use.

The North Warwickshire Borough Council has been consulted as required by section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public right of way over the land situate at **Mancetter** shown by a continuous bold line on the map attached to this order and described in the Schedule to this order shall be extinguished after 28 days from the date of confirmation of this order.

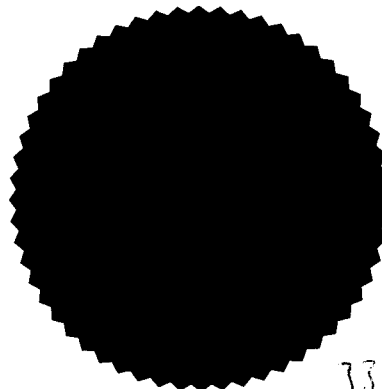
SCHEDULE

**DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATH OR WAY
(Between Points A and B on the Order map)**

That section of Public Footpath AE101 from Point B approximately 58 metres north west of Hartshill Wharf, Hartshill, running generally west north west for approximately 280 metres to Point A approximately 328 metres west north west of Hartshill Wharf, Hartshill.

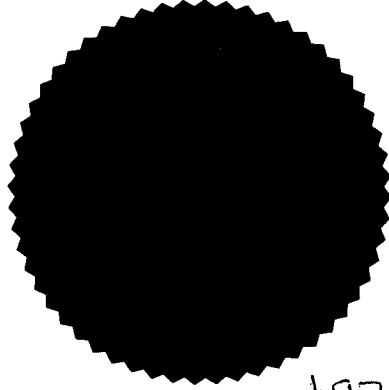

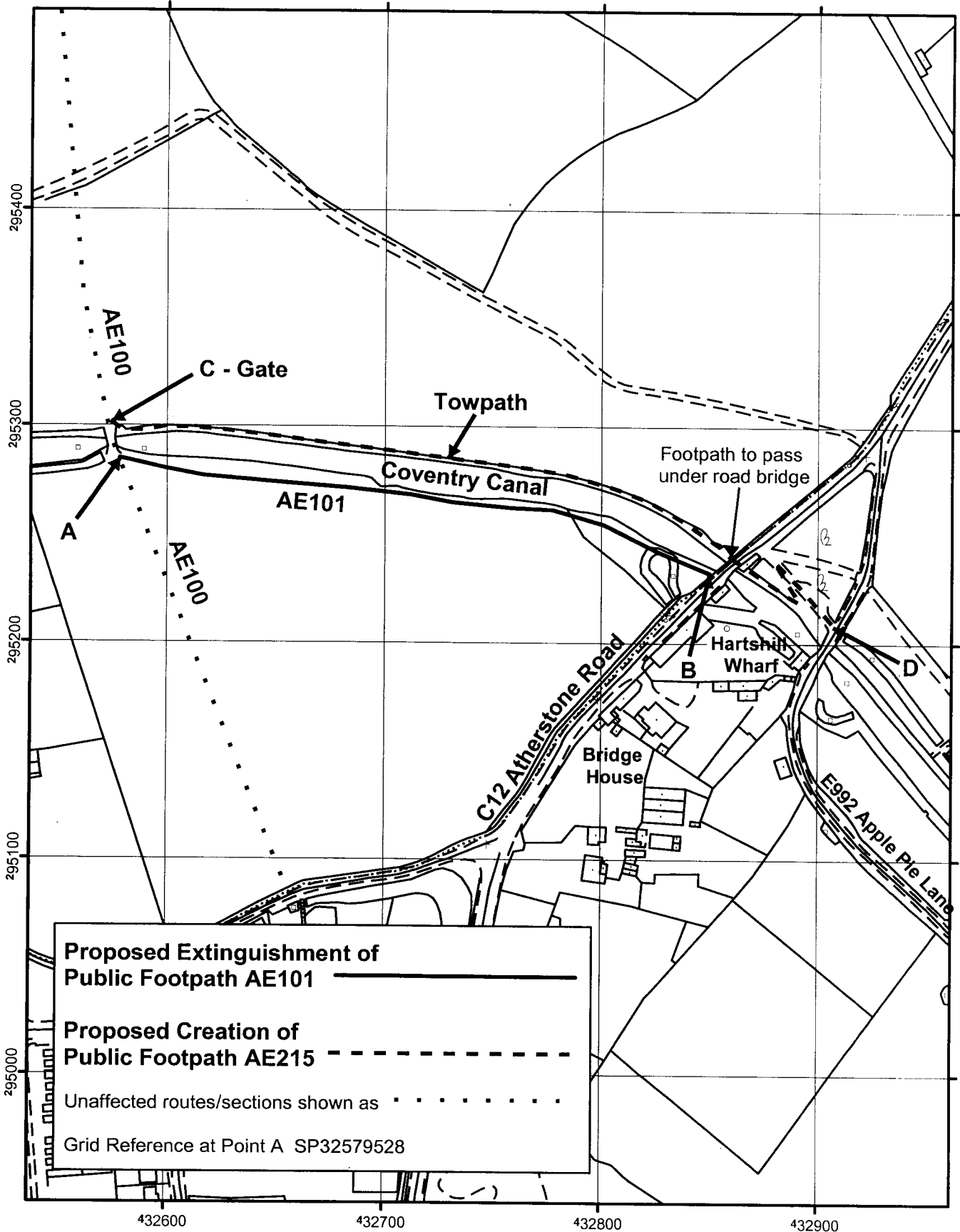
