What YOU can do to help:

As residents you are more likely to know the names of the people causing problems, we need **you** to identify and provide the local PCSO and Police with the names of the people who may be causing Anti Social Behaviour.

We need you to:

- Report all incidents of anti social behaviour including the illegal use of motor vehicles to the police on **01926 415000**.
- Name the individuals involved.
- Support the Parish, Borough and County Councils to offer diversionary activities for the young people.
- If you live in a Neighbourhood Watch Scheme area, speak with your local coordinator to get the regular police updates.

Anti Social Behaviour process:

How the Police and Councils deal with Anti Social Behaviour

1. A letter to parents
2. Monitoring young peoples actions
3. Family asked to attend the police station
4. Young person offered Acceptable Behaviour Contract
5. Evidence collected for an Anti Social Behaviour Order
6. Diversionary and outreach sessions.

The Problem: Following residents reports of

- nuisance motorcycles,
- quad bikes and
- anti social behaviour

around Westwood Road, the tow path and Mancetter recreation ground, a multi agency meeting was held and the following actions were agreed.

Action being taken:

To produce this leaflet to let local residents know what has happened, what the police and partners are doing to address the problems both immediately and in the longer term, along with information on the process that already exists for **you** to help us make your community a safe and enjoyable place to live.

Nuisance Motorcycles and Quad bikes:

The Police will:

- Patrol the site with the off road motorcycle team. They will catch and prosecute those using motorcycles anti-socially
- Request the motorcycle team to do a presentation at schools regarding the illegal use of motorcycles and activities that have occurred over the summer
- Investigate the potential extension of retail radio and licence restrictions
- Promote the reporting of incidents to local residents
- Act as a deterrent to people causing the problems

PACT: Partners and Communities Together

- Gather names so clear links can be made between the school, the police and the offenders homes – this will help with the Anti Social Behaviour process (detailed later in this leaflet).

The Borough Council will:



- Provide Section 59 Motor vehicle warning signs
- CALL 4 SPORT and Activities 4U staff will visit the site and speak to anyone found
- Develop a leaflet to inform residents how to report incidents.

Warwickshire County Council will:

- Work with the Police to distribute leaflets and posters to ensure residents are aware of the legalities around owning a motorcycle.

British waterways will:

- Work with the Police to investigate the potential installation of an additional CCTV column.

Partners will:

- Work together to investigate the feasibility of a legal motorcycle track
